Chevy Suburbans take jobs in easy stride that would stop most wagons in their tracks. A Series C20 Suburban with an optional 454 Cu. In. V8 gas engine and Heavy-Duty Trailering Package can move up to 15,500 lbs., including itself, passengers, equipment, cargo and trailer. No ordinary wagon can come close to that. Or to Suburban's load space or available comfortable seating for up to nine people.

Optional 6.2 Liter Diesel. The 6.2 Liter Diesel could well be the power of the future, especially in vehicles like the Suburban. Since the introduction of the totally new 6.2 Liter Diesel last year—specifically designed for truck use—it's been popular with Suburban owners. Diesel power traditionally offers good mileage and is hardworking. And this 6.2 Liter Diesel available in all Suburbans is rated at 130 SAE net horsepower in the 10 Series and 135 SAE net horsepower in the 20 Series—just the right size to give the Suburban impressive efficiency and towing power up to 13,500 lbs. The diesel is a proven engine for a great many Suburban uses.

Superwagon tough. Surrounding the Suburban's 144 cu. ft. of standard usable interior room is a tough Chevy truck body. There's a strong, deep-section truck frame. Rugged girder beam front suspension. A computer-matched brake system. Double-wall doors. Double-wall front fenders with both steel panels of special Zincrometal.[®] And new for 1983 is a Zincrometal hood inner panel, plus new anti-chip coating that protects the Suburban's lower body surfaces.

The Silverado trim: Inside the top-of-the-line Suburban you'll find as much luxury as you'll find wide-open room. Choose either cut-pile velour cloth upholstery in four colors or leather-grain vinyl in three colors. Silverado extras range from new pewter-toned brushed aluminum finish instrumentation to the new Deluxe

Front Appearance package. **The Scottsdale trim:** This luxury package includes a full-length, color-keyed insulated headliner. And because it's truck-tough, the Suburban offers payloads of up to 3930 lbs., including people, cargo and equipment.



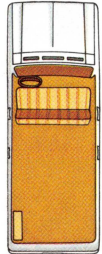

TO ROUGH WITHOUT STOPPING.

The Suburban's available 4-wheel-drive system features automatic locking front hubs. It also has a lightweight aluminum transfer case with synchronized gears that allow you to shift from 2WD to 4WD at

speeds up to 25 MPH. When you shift from freewheeling 2WD to 4WD, the hubs automatically lock up, eliminating the need to get out of the cab to set them. To revert to 2WD, simply stop the vehicle, shift into 2WD,

slowly back up about ten feet and go on your way. Even with 4WD, the Suburban's entry height is a convenient 21.6 to 23.6 inches, depending on model, with over a full 7.0 inches of ground clearance.

A BIG CHOICE OF GAS OR DIESEL POWER.

Optional V8 diesel engine. There are two versions of the 6.2 Liter Diesel offered. One for the 10-Series Suburbans up to and including 8500 lbs. GVWR, and one for the 20-Series Suburbans rated above that. Both models feature the Ricardo Comet V precombustion chamber design that contributes to high efficiency and impressive emissions control. A block and fuel line heater is standard to aid in cold-weather starting. Also included is an anti-moisture system to help eliminate the problem of water in some diesel fuel.

V8 gasoline engines. The standard engine on the Series C10 model is the 5.0 Liter (305 Cu. In.) V8 with Electronic Spark Control. It provides surprising acceleration and

horsepower for an engine of its size. It has a 9.2-to-1 compression ratio and is designed to run most efficiently on unleaded fuel at maximum spark advance. (Not available in California.) A larger 5.7 Liter (350 Cu. In.) V8 is available for the C10 and standard on the C20. A 7.4 Liter (454 Cu. In.) V8 is optional for the C20. On K10 and K20 4-wheel-drive Suburbans, the 5.7 Liter (350 Cu. In.) V8 is standard.

4-speed automatic transmission with overdrive. It features a fourth gear overdrive ratio that decreases engine speed by 30% on the highway. Standard on all C10 models and optional on all other models except the C20 with the 7.4 Liter (454 Cu. In.) V8 engine. A 3-speed automatic is optional on all C-K20 models and required with 7.4 Liter engine. A 4-speed manual is standard on C20 and K10-20 models.

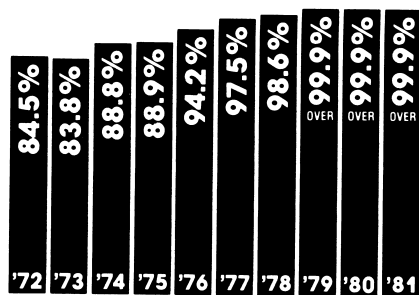

A WORD ABOUT ASSEMBLY, COMPONENTS AND OPTIONAL EQUIPMENT IN THESE CHEVROLET PRODUCTS.

The Chevy Suburbans described in this catalog (Series C10, C20, K10 and K20) are assembled at facilities of General Motors Corporation operated by Chevrolet Motor Division.

These vehicles incorporate thousands of different components produced by various divisions of General Motors and by various suppliers to General Motors. From time to time during the manufacturing process, it may be necessary, in order to meet public demand for particular vehicles or equipment, or to meet federally mandated emissions, safety and fuel economy requirements, or for other reasons, to produce these products with different components or differently sourced components than initially scheduled. All such components have been approved for use in these Chevrolet products and will provide the quality performance

associated with the Chevrolet name.

With respect to factory-installed extra-cost optional equipment, make certain you specify the type of equipment you desire on your vehicle when ordering it from your dealer. Some options may be unavailable when your vehicle is built. Your dealer receives advice regarding current availability of options. You may ask the dealer for this information. GM also requests the dealer to advise you if an option you ordered is unavailable. We suggest that you verify that your vehicle includes the optional equipment you ordered or, if there are changes, that they are acceptable to you.
